Section 3111.25 Acknowledgment of paternity is final and enforceable.

Effective: March 22, 2001

Legislation: Senate Bill 180 - 123rd General Assembly

An acknowledgment of paternity is final and enforceable without ratification by a court when the acknowledgment has been filed with the office of child support, the information on the acknowledgment has been entered in the birth registry, and the acknowledgment has not been rescinded and is not subject to possible rescission pursuant to section 3111.27 of the Revised Code.
