Rule 109:2-7-02 Basic courses for evaluators.

Effective: January 1, 2001

(A) Any person who conducts examinations for law enforcement canine units is required to complete
the core course for evaluators and one or both of the patrol-related and special purpose courses.

(a) Tracking
(b) Article search
(c) Narcotics detection
(d) Explosives detection
(e) Any other topic designated by the executive director
