Rule 109:4-1-02 Purpose of the office of the Ohio attorney general, consumer protection section.

The purpose of the office of the Ohio attorneygeneral, consumer protection section is to protect the consuming public and topromote compliance by suppliers and other persons within its jurisdiction byenforcing the following laws, including but not limited to the Ohio ConsumerSales Practices Act, sections 1345.01 to 1345.13 of the Revised Code; the OhioHome Solicitation Sales Act, sections 1345.21 to 1345.28 and 1345.99 of theRevised Code; the Ohio Prepaid Entertainment Contract Act, sections 1345.41 to1345.51 of the Revised Code; the Ohio Odometer Rollback and Disclosure Act, sections 4549.41 to 4549.51 of the Revised Code; the Ohio TelephoneSolicitation Sales Act, sections 4719.01 to 4719.18 and 4719.99 of the RevisedCode; the Ohio Credit Service Organization Act, sections 4712.01 to 4712.14 and 4712.99 of the Revised Code; the Ohio Business Opportunity Purchaser's Protection Act, section 1334.01 to 1334.15 and 1334.99 of the Revised Code; the Ohio Anti-Pyramid Sales Law, sections 1333.91 to 1333.95 of the Revised Code; the Ohio Mortgage Broker's Act, section 1322.52 of the Revised Code; the Ohio Condominium Sales Act, sections 5311.25 to 5311.27 of the Revised Code; and sections 1345.30, 1345.31, 1345.52, 1345.77, 1345.81, 1345.90 to 1345.95,1317.21 to 1317.24 of the Revised Code, and any other state and/or federal lawsdesigned to protect the rights of the consuming public consistent with thelegal authority of the office of the attorney general.
