

Ohio Administrative Code Rule 1509-1-18 Subpoenas.

Effective: May 5, 2019

If a party to a proceeding pending before thecommission desires to secure the attendance of a witness to testify in saidparty's behalf, said party shall, at least twelve days prior to the dateof hearing thereon, unless such time is lessened by the commission, file withthe commission a praecipe therefor comparable to like praecipes used inproceedings before a common pleas court. The full name and address, includingstreet name and number and county of residence, of the witness must be given; and if the praecipe is for a subpoena duces tecum, the specific books andrecords which the witness is required to bring with him shall be described indetail. Witness fees, if any, shall be paid directly to said witness by theparty filing the praecipe therefor. Consistent with section 1509.36 of theRevised Code and with the Ohio criminal rules, the commission may designate asubpoena to be personally served by an attorney at law or by any other persondeemed appropriate under the criminal rules.
