

Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3335-23-01 Introduction and purpose.

The code of student conduct, a part of the OhioAdministrative Code, is established to foster and protect the core missions ofthe university; to foster the scholarly and civic development of theuniversitys students in a safe and secure learning environment, and toprotect the people, properties and processes that support the university andits missions. The core missions of the university are research, teaching andlearning, and service. Preservation of academic freedom and free and openexchange of ideas and opinions for all members of the university are central tothese missions.
