

Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3335-23-06 Amnesty.

Effective: January 25, 2024

At the universitys discretion, amnesty maybe extended to students who may be hesitant to report a code of student conductviolation to university officials because they fear that they themselves may beaccused of minor policy violations, including but not limited to underagedrinking, at the time of the incident. If a student is granted amnesty, aneducational discussion or other informal resolution may be considered, but nouniversity conduct proceedings under this rule will result.

At the universitys discretion, amnesty mayalso be extended on a case-by-case basis for minor policy violations whenstudents request assistance for others in need, including the person receiving assistance. If a student is granted amnesty, an educational discussion or other informal resolution may be considered, but no university conduct proceedings under the code of student conduct will result. In cases of academic misconduct, need does not include a student's inability to complete an assignment without assistance.
