Rule 3335-23-07 Filing of complaint and initiation of charges.

Effective: January 25, 2024

A complaint alleging a code of student conductviolation should be made to the university as soon as practicable in accordancewith paragraph (A) of rule 3335-23-05 of the Administrative Code. Absentextraordinary circumstances, the university will not take action on complaintsfiled more than six months from the discovery of non-academic misconduct(paragraphs (B) to (S) of rule 3335-23-04 of the Administrative Code) or thirtybusiness days for academic misconduct (paragraph (A) of rule 3335-23-04 of the Administrative Code). These time limitations do not apply to complaints of sexual misconduct or other protected class discrimination andharassment.

Absent extraordinary circumstances, the universitymust initiate charges, if any, within one year of the filing of the complaint. This time limitation does not apply to complaints of sexual misconduct or otherprotected class discrimination and harassment. In all cases, a student chargedwith one or more code of student conduct violations has the right to be heard, subject to the student conduct procedures.
