

Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3335-23-13 Attendance.

Effective: January 25, 2024

Because the most accurate and fair review of thefacts can best be accomplished when all parties are present, the respondent andinvited witnesses are strongly encouraged to attend and participate. If anindividual does not choose to attend a hearing, the charges will be reviewed asscheduled based on the available information, and a decision will be made. Although no inference may be drawn against a student for failing to attend ahearing or remaining silent, the hearing will proceed and the conclusion willbe based on the evidence presented. No decision shall be based solely on therespondent's failure to attend the hearing or answer the charges. Inspecial circumstances, written statements may be considered by the hearing bodywhen a respondent or witness does not attend or fully participate in ahearing.
