

## Ohio Administrative Code

Rule 3357:15-17-05 Physical development, planning, space utilization, and maintenance.

Effective: June 6, 2022

Stark state college thoroughly plans the development, space utilization, and maintenance of college facilities and grounds.

- (A) The chief financial officer/vice president of business at their discretion, may utilize the expertise of a professional planning or architectural firm, the Ohio facilities construction commission (OFCC), or utilize the expertise of the college faculty and staff to deliver a plan for the physical development and planning of the college. The planning encompasses the following components:
- (1) Concepts of development include the physical features, function, quality, and aesthetics that fit the college motif.
- (2) Parameters of design standards include the scale, material, style, and colors. Parameters also consider density measures and travel time and distance of prospective students.
- (3) Use of college land includes buildings, open space, parking, and circulation.
- (4) Detailed plans pertaining to specific buildings include the preservation/renovation/modification of existing buildings and the demolition or construction of new buildings.
- (5) Development capital is considered for source of, the application of, and the time schedule for funds.
- (B) The chief financial officer/vice president of business will file all space inventory and utilization reports required by the Ohio department of higher education.
- (C) The chief financial officer/vice president of business is responsible for the maintenance of the buildings and grounds of Stark state college.
