The executive committee shall be elected annuallyat the first meeting of the new fiscal year of the council and shall consist ofthe chair of the council, the vice chair, and four additional members. Theimmediate past chair of the council may be elected to serve as a fifthadditional member of the executive committee with the approval of council, andso long as the immediate past chair is and continues to be a member of council.Four members shall constitute a quorum and the committee may act upon themajority vote of at least a quorum of its members who are present at themeeting. The executive committee shall, during the interval between meetings ofthe council, possess and exercise all of the powers of the council inmanagement of the business and affairs of the council except as to such mattersas the council has by resolution expressly reserved to itself, including butnot limited to rules promulgation pursuant to rule 3379-13-01 of theAdministrative Code. In addition, the executive committee is authorized toapprove the director's application for funds to the "NationalEndowment for the Arts." The executive committee shall keep full andaccurate records and accounts of its proceedings and transactions. All actionby the executive committee shall be reported to the council at its meeting nextsucceeding such action and shall be subject to revision and alteration by thecouncil, provided that no rights of third persons shall be affected by any suchrevision or alteration.
