

## Ohio Administrative Code

Rule 3745-104-22 Program two prevention program: compliance audits.

Effective: August 5, 2021

- (A) The owner or operator shall certify that they have evaluated compliance with the provisions of rules 3745-104-17 to 3745-104-23 of the Administrative Code at least every three years to verify that the procedures and practices developed under chapter 3745-104 of the Administrative Code are adequate and are being followed.
- (B) The compliance audit shall be conducted by at least one person knowledgeable in the process.
- (C) The owner or operator shall do the following:
- (1) Develop a report of the audit findings.
- (2) Promptly determine and document an appropriate response to each of the findings of the compliance audit and document that deficiencies have been corrected.
- (3) Retain the two most recent compliance audit reports. This requirement does not apply to any compliance audit report that is more than five years old.
