

## Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-50-54 Duration of permits.

Effective: March 24, 2017

- (A) Ohio hazardous waste permits shall be effective for a fixed term not to exceed ten years.
- (B) Except as provided in rule 3745-50-56 of the Administrative Code, the term of a permit shall not be extended by modification beyond the maximum duration specified in this rule.
- (C) The director may issue the permit for a duration that is less than the full allowable term under this rule.
- (D) The director will review each permit for a land disposal facility five years after the date of permit issuance and the permit will be modified as necessary, as provided in rule 3745-50-51 of the Administrative Code.
