

AUTHENTICATED, OHIO LEGISLATIVE SERVICE COMMISSION DOCUMENT #314642

Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3769-3-03 Totalizator.

Effective: January 26, 2024

No permit will be issued to an applicant unless atotalizator system approved by the commission is installed for pari-mutuelwagering. Each permit holder will provide and maintain in good working order atelephone system connecting the stewards or judges stand with the office of thepari-mutuel plant and any other stations which the commission and/or the permitholder deem necessary. The permit holder will also provide a telephone in thestewards or judges stand which permits the stewards or judges to contact an offtrack location without going through a switchboard. Each permit holder willprovide and maintain in good working order a system of bells which will be rungfrom the stewards or judges stand and/or tote room to signal the close ofwagering on all races other than those races on which there is a common ari-mutuel pool that is processed and priced by other than the permitholder's totalizator system. A button will also be provided in thestewards or judges stand and/or tote room which, when pressed, will lockticket-issuing machines and close wagering, for each race other than thoseraces on which there is a common pari-mutuel pool that is processed and pricedby other than the permit holder's totalizator system. A steward or judgeand the totalizator operator will be in verbal communication one minute priorto scheduled post time for each race other than those races on which there is acommon pari-mutuel pool that is processed and priced by other than the permitholder's totalizator system. The race will not start if there is no verbalcommunication between the steward or judge and the totalizator operator. Attracks where the next previous year's daily average handle was two hundredfifty thousand or more, the term "totalizator of approved design" will be one which displays to the public on a board or television screen, running totals of amounts wagered, in each of the win, place and show pools oneach entry in each race. No totalizator may be deemed one of approved designunless it is capable of registering by automatic mechanical, electric orelectronic means on central aggregators all wagers made on each horse, entry, or the field, in each of the win, place and show pools, and displaying thetotals so registered in such a way as to permit ready tabulation thereof by the commission's representative. The total so registered on such aggregator will not be cleared therefrom until such representative has had reasonable opportunity to record them.
