

Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3769-7-12 Physical examination.

Effective: May 10, 2021

An applicant for an apprentice jockey license or ajockey license shall pass a physical examination given within the previous welve months by a licensed physician affirming fitness to participate as aapprentice jockey or jockey as well as a baseline concussion test using themost current SCAT testing protocol. The applicant for a apprentice jockey or jockey license may have to go to a licensed optometrist for an eye examinationaffirming fitness to participate as a apprentice jockey or jockey. The resultsof the physical examination, eye examination and the baseline concussion testshall be provided by the jockey or apprentice jockey to the commission or thestewards upon request. The stewards may require that any jockey be reexaminedat any time and may refuse to allow any jockey to ride pending completion of such examination.
