

Ohio Administrative Code

Rule 4713-5-28 Attire for applicants taking examinations at the board.

Effective: February 12, 2024

- (A) All applicants shall wear appropriate clothing when scheduled to take the state licensure examination.
- (1) Clothing that is comfortable and practical for work or a school uniform are acceptable attire. A clean smock or apron may be worn over attire.
- (2) The following attire is not permitted in the examination center during an examination: clothing that shows excessive skin, clothing with offensive language, sleeveless attire, torn, dirty or tattered clothing, or other clothing as determined by Board staff.
- (B) An applicant not admitted to the test center due to attire shall be dismissed, and required to reschedule for the state examination.
