

Ohio Administrative Code Rule 4901:2-21-01 Definitions.

Effective: June 17, 2019

- (A) "Applicant" means any for-hire carrier who submits to the commission the required application forms necessary to receive a certificate.
- (B) "Certificate" means certificate of public convenience and necessity.
- (C) "Certificate Application" means the online platform developed by the commission to allow motor carriers to apply for and renew a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
- (D) "Commission" means the public utilities commission of Ohio.
- (E) "For-hire motor carrier" has the same meaning as in section 4921.01 of the Revised Code.
- (F) "Household goods" has the same meaning as in section 4921.01 of the Revised Code.
- (G) "Intrastate commerce" has the same meaning as in section 4921.01 of the Revised Code.
- (H) "Register" or "Registration" means the process by which a for-hire motor carrier submits to the commission, the required application forms necessary to receive a certificate.
- (I) "Staff" means employees of the transportation department of the commission.
