Rule 5703-15-02 Notice relative to license revocation proceeding.

Effective: November 23, 2018

Whenever the tax commissioner finds that awholesale or retail dealer is advertising, offering to sell, or sellingcigarettes at a price in violation of the provisions of section 1333.11, etseq. of the Revised Code, a written notice will be sent to such dealer bycertified mail charging him with such violation and advising him that thirtydays from the date of receipt of such notice an order will be issued by the commissioner suspending or revoking his wholesale or retail cigarettedealer's license unless, within said thirty-day period, a hearing isrequested in accordance with the provisions of section 119.07 of the RevisedCode.

If a hearing is requested, the commissioner willset a date, time and place for same in accordance with the provisions of section 119.07 of the Revised Code, at which time the dealer may appear inperson or be represented by his attorney or such other person as he may designate, to present his position, arguments, or contentions relative to saidcharge.
