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PHYSICAL AND MENTAL CONDITIONS WITH A HIGH PROBABILITY OF RESULTING IN A DEVELOPMENTAL DELAY

Newborn Conditions

Very low birth weight (i.e., less than 1,500 grams) diagnosed at birth or within thirty calendar days after birth with:

- (1) Intraventricular hemorrhage (grade III), and/or
- (2) Chronic lung disease (bronchopulmonary dysplasia), and/or
- (3) Retinopathy of prematurity (stage IV or stage V)

Diagnosed Conditions in Neonates, Infants, or Toddlers

- (1) Chromosomal conditions
- (2) Inborn errors of metabolism
- (3) Neurological conditions:
 - (a) Blindness, including visual impairments
 - (b) Cerebral palsy
 - (c) Deafness, including hearing impairments
 - (d) Epilepsy/seizure disorder
 - (e) Hydrocephalus
 - (f) Hypoxic ischemic encephalopathy
 - (g) Intraventricular hemorrhage (grade IV)

- (h) Microcephaly
- (i) Muscular dystrophy
- (j) Spina bifida
- (k) Spinal muscular atrophy
- (l) Traumatic brain injury
- (4) Other:
 - (a) Acquired immune deficiency syndrome
 - (b) Attachment disorder
 - (c) Autism spectrum disorder
 - (d) Blood lead level of five micrograms per deciliter or greater
 - (e) Cranio-facial anomalies
 - (f) Cyanotic congenital heart disease
 - (g) Fetal alcohol syndrome
 - (h) Infant of untreated mother of phenylketonuria
 - (i) Infection, fetal/neonatal (herpes, syphilis, cytomegalovirus, toxoplasmosis, and rubella)
 - (j) Neonatal abstinence syndrome
 - (k) Sickle cell anemia
