

Ohio Revised Code Section 1345.99 Penalty.

Effective: May 11, 2018

Legislation: Senate Bill 223, House Bill 52 - 132nd General Assembly

- (A) Whoever violates section 1345.23 or 1345.24 of the Revised Code is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.
- (B) Whoever violates division (C) of section 1345.30 or division (D) of section 1345.76 of the Revised Code shall be fined not more than one thousand dollars.
- (C) Whoever knowingly violates division (E) of section 1345.02 or knowingly violates section 1345.18 of the Revised Code is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree for a first offense and a misdemeanor of the second degree for any subsequent offense.
- (D) Whoever recklessly violates section 1345.032 of the Revised Code shall be fined the following:
- (1) For the first violation, not more than one hundred dollars for each solicitation document distributed:
- (2) For any subsequent violation, not more than two hundred dollars for each solicitation document distributed.
- (E) Whoever negligently violates section 1345.022 of the Revised Code shall be fined not more than one thousand dollars.
