DTaP/DTP/DTTdap/Td Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis	Four doses of DTaP, DTP or DT or any combination.	Kindergarten 5 doses of DTaP, DTP or DT, or any combination, if the fourth dose was administered prior to the fourth birthday. Grades 1-12 3-4 doses of DTaP, DTP, DT or Td or any combination. Grades 7-8 One dose of Tdap or Td vaccine must be administered prior to entry.
POLIO	Three doses of OPV or IPV or any combination of OPV or IPV.	K-1 A minimum of three doses. The final dose must have been given on or after the fourth birthday, regardless of the number of previous doses; four doses if a combination of POV and IPV was administered. Grades 2-12 Four doses if a combination of OPV and IPV was administered. Four doses if all OPV or all IPV is required if the third dose of either vaccine was administered prior to the fourth birthday.
MMR Measles, Mumps, Rubella	One dose of MMR administered on or after the 1st birthday.	K-12 Two doses of MMR. Dose one must be administered on or after the first birthday. The second dose must be administered at least twenty-eight days after dose one.
Hib Haemophilus Influenzae Type b	Three or four doses depending on the vaccine type and the age when the child began the first dose and the last dose is after twelve months or one dose if given on or after fifteen months of age.	None

<p>HEP B Hepatitis B</p>	<p>Three doses of Hepatitis B</p>	<p>K-12 Three doses of hepatitis B. The second dose must be administered at least twenty-eight days after the first dose. The third dose must be given at least sixteen weeks after the first dose and at least eight weeks after the second dose. The last dose in the series (third or fourth dose) must not be administered before age twenty-four weeks.</p>
<p>Varicella (Chickenpox)</p>	<p>None</p>	<p>K-1 Two doses of Varicella vaccine must be administered prior to entry. Grade 2-5 One dose of varicella vaccine must be administered on or after the first birthday.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The four day "grace" period applies to all age and interval minimums. If MMR and Varicella are not given on the same day, the doses must be separated by at least twenty-eight days with no grace period. • The Tdap and Varicella requirements will be progressive. • Only full doses of vaccine using proper intervals shall be counted as valid doses. • Please contact the Ohio Department of Health Immunization Program at (800) 282-0546 or (614) 466-4643 with questions or concerns regarding the immunization schedule.
