

Appendix A to Rule 5101:2-14-16

First-Aid Box Contents

The first-aid box shall contain all of the following:

- One roll of hypoallergenic first-aid tape.
- Individually wrapped sterile gauze squares in assorted sizes.
- Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes.
- Tweezers.
- Gauze rolled bandage.
- Rounded end scissors.
- Tooth preservation system or fresh chilled milk in which to transport a lost tooth (required only in homes which serve school age children).
- A current guide to emergency first aid.
- A working digital thermometer.
- Disposable non-latex gloves.
- A working flashlight.
- An instant cold pack that has not been activated or ice.
- Sealable leak-proof plastic bags in assorted sizes or double bagged plastic bags that can be securely tied for materials soiled with blood or bodily fluids.
- Pocket mask or face shield, appropriate for all ages of children in care at the home, for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) administration.

In addition to the above items, on field trips or when transporting away from the home, the following items are required:

- Soap.
- Bottled water.
