Rule 1501:31-23-02 Species designated as threatened.

Effective: July 6, 2026

Notwithstanding any other provision of this or any other wildlife order, or Chapters 1531. and 1533. of the Revised Code, the following native species and subspecies of the wild animals are designated as threatened.
