



Ohio Administrative Code Rule 311-1-06 Marine patrol uniform.

Effective: December 15, 2025

- (A) The sheriff may authorize wear of the marine patrol uniform by appropriately assigned deputies.
 - (B) The marine patrol uniform shall consist, at a minimum of the following uniform items:
 - (1) A shirt:
 - (a) The length of which to be set at the discretion of the sheriff for performance, environment, safety, and comfort;
 - (b) Conforming to the standard set forth in the American National Standard for High-Visibility Public Safety Vests promulgated by the American National Standard Institute and the International Safety Equipment Association; and
 - (c) The word "SHERIFF" in all capital letters must be embroidered on the front of the shirt or an embroidered patch attached to the front of the shirt.
 - (2) Trousers set at the discretion of the sheriff for performance, environment, safety, and comfort;
 - (3) Footwear selected at the sheriff's discretion; and
 - (4) All mandatory uniform items specified in rules 311-1-14 to 311-1-16 of the Administrative Code.
