


Ohio Administrative Code

Rule 3304-1-08 Method of notice for public hearings.

Effective: November 1, 2020

- (A) OOD shall conduct a public hearing for all administrative rules filed in compliance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code.
- (B) At least thirty days before the public hearing, OOD shall prepare a notice of public hearing, which includes all of the following:
- (1) A statement that it is OOD's intention to propose, amend, or rescind rules.
- (2) The date, time, and location of the public hearing.
- (3) A general statement of the subject matter to which the proposed rule(s), amendment(s), or rescission(s) relate.
- (4) The reason for proposing, amending, or rescinding the rule(s).
- (5) A statement that the rule(s) shall be available for review on the OOD website.
- (6) A statement that the public hearing shall be conducted in accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code.
- (C) At least thirty days before the public hearing, the notice of public hearing shall:
- (1) Be posted on the OOD website at https://ood.ohio.gov/;
- (2) Be sent by mailing electronically or otherwise to affected providers or other interested parties who have opted-in to receive notices from OOD through the administrative rules mailbox at OOD.AdministrativeRules@ood.ohio.gov; and



- (3) Be sent by mailing electronically or otherwise to each member of the OOD council.
- (D) At least thirty days before the public hearing, OOD shall submit the notice of public hearing to the legislative service commission for publication in the register of Ohio.
