

Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3357:15-13-17 Graduation requirements.

Effective: August 29, 2025

A student becomes eligible for an appliedbachelor's degree, associate degree when the student has completed all therequirements of the program that the student is enrolled in based upon thecatalog-in-force and change of major policy (rule 3357:15-13-28 of theAdministrative Code) and as defined by the Ohio department of higher education(ODHE). Students must also have a grade point average (GPA) of 2.00 or above intheir technical major and a cumulative GPA of 2.00 or above. For programs thatdo not have technical concentration courses, no technical GPA is calculated.Based on accreditation standards, certain programs may require a highertechnical and cumulative GPA. The credits transferred from other institutionsmust be in accordance with the transfer and articulation policy (rule3357:15-13-25 of the Administrative Code) and may be used by a student towardcompletion of an applied bachelor's dgree and an associate degree at Starkstate college. Coursework over ten years old is subject to review andacceptance by the chair of the department offering the course or the dean ofthat division. However, Stark state college will consider granting permissionto a candidate under a catalog more than ten years old if the candidate hasbeen enrolled continuously and the degree program has not changed appreciably.
