Rule 3701-22-65 Order to suspend operations of a health care service.

Effective: August 31, 2025

- (A) In addition with the actions taken by the director against a hospital with a health care service under paragraph (B)(1) and (B)(2) of rule 3701-22-05 of the Administrative Code, the director may issue an order to suspend operations to a health care service, for the following:
- (1) The director determines, based on clinical criteria including, but not limited to, major complications, the frequency of emergency transfers, and death, that the service poses an imminent threat of serious physical or life-threatening danger to the recipients of health care services;
- (2) Failure of the service to meet designated quality outcome benchmarks, as evidenced by annual reports of the service's chosen data registry reports, or the service's annual reportable interventions; or
- (3) Failure of the service to comply with the provisions of this chapter.
