

Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-205-36 Reporting - process vents.

Effective: June 12, 2023

- (A) A semiannual report shall be submitted by owners and operators subject to the requirements of rules 3745-205-30 to 3745-205-36 of the Administrative Code to the director by dates specified by the director. The report shall include the following information:
- (1) The U.S. EPA identification number, name, and address of the facility.
- (2) For each month during the semiannual reporting period, dates when the control device exceeded or operated outside of the design specifications as described in paragraph (C)(4) of rule 3745-205-35 of the Administrative Code and as indicated by the control device monitoring required by paragraph (F) of rule 3745-205-33 of the Administrative Code and such exceedances were not corrected within twenty-four hours, or that a flare operated with visible emissions as described in paragraph (D) of rule 3745-205-33 of the Administrative Code and as determined by method 22 monitoring, the duration and cause of each exceedance or visible emissions, and any corrective measures taken.
- (B) If, during the semiannual reporting period, the control device does not exceed or operate outside of the design specifications as described in paragraph (C)(4) of rule 3745-205-35 of the Administrative Code for more than twenty-four hours or a flare does not operate with visible emissions as described in paragraph (D) of rule 3745-205-33 of the Administrative Code, a report to the director is not required.
