Rule 3769-6-07 Claims.

Effective: July 13, 2025

- (A) Any horse starting in a claiming race shall be subject to claim for its entered price.
 - (B) All claims must be made in writing on forms and in envelopes furnished by the permit holder.
 - (C) Both forms and envelopes must be filled out completely and must be sufficiently accurate to identify the claim or the claim will be void.
 - (D) Notwithstanding any designation of sex or age appearing on the racing program or in any racing publication, the claimant of a horse shall be solely responsible for determining the age or sex of the horse claimed.
