

## Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3769-6-08 Persons eligible to claim.

Effective: July 13, 2025

- (A) Any Ohio licensed owner or any person holding an eligibility to claim license may make a claim for any horse subject to claim. Claims may be made by an authorized agent but only for the account of the person for whom they are agent.
- (B) An eligibility to claim license may be issued by the Ohio state racing commission subject to rules 3769-2-18, 3769-2-26 and 3769-2-30 of the Administrative Code, to any applicant who provides a completed fingerprint card, the name of a licensed trainer who will assume the responsibility for the care of the horse claimed, along with the requisite fee.
- (C) An eligibility to claim license is valid until the successful claim or purchase of a horse. The successful claimant or purchaser will apply for an owner's license prior to entering the horse.
- (D) Any person claiming a horse under this rule must also comply with rules 3769-6-14 and 3769-6-15 of the Administrative Code.
