## Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3769-6-38 Failure to operate. Effective: July 13, 2025

If when the starter gives the signal for the startof any race, the doors at the front of one or more of the stalls should fail toopen, causing the occupant or occupants to be left, or if a horse is not in thestarting gate stall when the field is dispatched, thereby causing a horse to beleft, the starter shall notify the stewards immediately, who shall notify theparimutuel department that such horse or horses so left shall be deemed for allpurposes not to have participated in said race but to have been withdrawntherefrom immediately subsequent to the finish of the next preceding race; andthe permit holder shall thereupon make disposition of wagers upon such horse orhorses in accordance with such notification by the stewards, and pursuant tothe provisions of rule 3769-4-38 of the Administrative Code. If such asituation should arise with respect to a race for which nominating, eligibilityor starting fees have been paid, all fees paid with relation to the horse orhorses left shall be refunded to the nominator or the respectivenominators.
