Rule 3772-21-05 Appearances, participation by and representation of parties.

Effective: April 19, 2012

- (A) Any party may be represented by an attorney who is licensed in Ohio. The attorney shall represent the party at the partys own expense. All attorneys who appear in a representative capacity on behalf of a party must file with the commission, at its Columbus office, a written notice of appearance setting forth:
- (1) The attorneys name, address, telephone number and bar number; and
- (2) The name and address of the party represented.
- (B) An attorney who has not filed an appearance may not address the hearing examiner or sign any briefs, motions or other writings filed with the commission in the matter.
- (C) An attorney may only withdraw his or her appearance upon written notice to the commission or hearing examiner assigned.
- (D) A natural person party may appear on his or her own behalf.
- (E) A partnership may be represented by a partner provided the partner is authorized to do so.
- (F) A limited liability company or corporation shall be represented by counsel.
