

Ohio Administrative Code Rule 4101:9-2-14 Coal mine occupations.

Effective: March 6, 2020

All occupations in or about any coal mine are prohibited for minors under eighteen years of age except the occupations of slate or other refuse picking at a picking table or picking chute in a tippleor breaker and occupations requiring the performance of duties solely inoffices or in repair or maintenance shops located in the surface part of any coal-mining plant.

Definitions:

- (A) The term "coal" shall mean any rank of coal including lignite, bituminous, and anthracite coals.
- (B) The term "all occupations in or about any coal mine" shall mean all types of work performed in any underground working, open-pit, or surface part of any coal-mining plant that contributes to the extraction, grading, cleaning or other handling of coal.
