

Ohio Administrative Code Rule 4713-7-10 Testing fraud.

Effective: January 2, 2025

- (A) Any individual who presents false identification or is caught attempting to test for another individual shall be barred from entering the examination, and the applicant shall receive a failing grade on any part of the examination scheduled for that day.
- (B) Any individual who is caught cheating on an examination shall be immediately removed from the examination and shall receive a failing grade on any part of the examination scheduled for that day.
- (C) Any individual who violates subsection (A) or (B) of this rule shall be prohibited from reapplying for examination until the resolution of any administrative action.
- (D) Any individual who violates subsection (A) or (B) of this rule shall be subject to additional disciplinary action from the board.
