Ohio Administrative Code

Rule 4715-9-01.3 Monitoring of nitrous oxide-oxygen (N2O-O2) minimal sedation; education or training requirements.

Effective: September 18, 2024

Each licensed dental hygienist seeking to monitornitrous oxide-oxygen ($N_2 O-O_2$) minimal sedation must have completed a basiclife-support training course certified by the American heart association, theAmerican red cross, or the American safety and health institute, and remaincurrent at all times when monitoring $N_2 O-O_2$ minimal sedation. In order to monitor $N_2 O-O_2$ minimal sedation the dental hygienist must have completed the education and examination requirements set forth in rule 4715-11-02.1 of the AdministrativeCode for the monitoring of $N_2 O-O_2$ minimal sedation for basic qualified personnel excepting that the licenseddental hygienist is not required to complete the stipulations set forth inparagraph (B)(40)(b) of rule 4715-11-02 of the Administrative Code.

Completion of basic life-support and all educationand examination requirements for the administration of $N_2 O O_2$ minimal sedation shall be documented on a form supplied by the board, with anynecessary supporting information attached. This form shall be maintained in thefacility(s) where the dental hygienist is working. The board retains the rightand authority, upon notification, to audit, monitor or request evidencedemonstrating adherence to Chapter 4715. of the Revised Code and/or agency 4715of the Administrative Code.
