



Ohio Administrative Code

Rule 4732-1-03 Fees.

Effective: January 1, 2025

Fees provided for throughout Chapter 4732. of the Revised Code shall be established by the board in the amounts not to exceed the maximum allowable pursuant to section 4732.26 of the Revised Code. Current fees on the effective date of this rule are subject to change by action of the board, the controlling board, and/or the general assembly. Information about fees may be obtained by making inquiry by email or telephone call to the board office. Such fees, which are payable by credit card in the board's online license management portal, include:

(A) Application and license fee - three hundred dollars;

(B) Biennial registration (renewal) fee assessed to psychologists and independent school psychologists - three hundred fifty dollars beginning July 1, 2014 and three hundred sixty dollars beginning July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2020, and three hundred sixty-five dollars beginning July 1, 2020 and thereafter, with the option of the fee being waived according to rule 4732-1-06 of the Administrative Code;

(C) Quinquennial registration (renewal) fee assessed to licensed school psychologists- three hundred dollars;

(D) Fee for reinstatement of a license - biennial registration fee as in paragraph (B) of this rule, plus a penalty fee of two hundred fifty dollars;

(E) Fee for retaking any examination administered by the board - fifty dollars;

(F) Fee for nonresident psychologist application to practice for no more than thirty days per year - one hundred fifty dollars.
