Rule 5160-4-33 Application of topical fluoride treatments by non-dentist providers.

Effective: [May 1, 2026](#)

- (A) Rendering providers. The following non-dentist practitioners may render topical fluoride treatments such as the application of fluoride varnish or silver diamine fluoride:
- (1) A physician;
 - (2) A physician assistant; or
 - (3) An advanced practice registered nurse.
- (B) Payment for the application of a topical fluoride treatment is made separately from payment for an evaluation and management service.
- (C) Payment may be made not more frequently than once per one hundred eighty days for the topical application of fluoride varnish to the teeth of a child younger than six years of age.
- (D) Payment may be made not more frequently than three times per tooth per year for the topical application of silver diamine fluoride.
