



## Ohio Administrative Code Rule 901:3-4-18 Reinstatement of a licenser.

Effective: February 12, 2024

---

The director may reinstate a licenser if all the conditions in division (D) of section 3717.11 of the Revised Code are met. Upon reinstatement, the director shall provide the licenser a set-time frame for survey which shall be no later than one year after reinstatement. The licenser shall be classified as provisional until the licenser has successfully passed the survey. If the director determines that the licenser is qualified to administer and enforce Chapter 3717. of the Revised Code, Chapter 3717-1 of the Administrative Code, and the applicable rules of this chapter, the director shall classify the licenser as approved. If the director determines that the licenser is not qualified, the director may propose to revoke the approval in accordance with paragraph (D) of rule 901:3-4-17 of the Administrative Code.
