



## Ohio Administrative Code

### Rule 901:5-27-03 Labeling seed as to kind and variety.

Effective: September 23, 2021

---

Seed kinds labeled with a brand name and not a variety name shall be labeled with the phrase "variety not stated." Varieties of the following kinds of seeds are generally labeled as to variety and shall be labeled as to kind and variety or, in lieu of the variety name, the phrase "variety not stated," or "VNS":

- (A) Alfalfa;
- (B) Barley;
- (C) Smooth brome grass;
- (D) Buckwheat;
- (E) Red clover;
- (F) Field corn;
- (G) Popcorn;
- (H) Sweet corn;
- (I) Kentucky bluegrass;
- (J) Crown vetch;
- (K) Tall fescue;
- (L) Red fescue;



(M) Chewings fescue;

(N) Foxtail millet;

(O) Orchard grass;

(P) Oats;

(Q) Rye;

(R) Ryegrass;

(S) Sorghum;

(T) Sorghum-Sudan hybrids;

(U) Soybeans;

(V) Spelt;

(W) Sudangrass;

(X) Sunflower;

(Y) Timothy;

(Z) Tobacco;

(AA) Birdsfoot trefoil;

(BB) Triticale;



(CC) Wheat; and

(DD) Tillage radish.
