Section 1901.185 Jurisdiction to foreclose lien on blighted parcel.

In addition to jurisdiction otherwise granted _____ in this chapter, the environmental division, where _____ established, _____ of the municipal court shall have jurisdiction within _____ its _____ territory in all of the following actions or proceedings and _____ to perform all of the following functions:

(A) To exercise exclusive original jurisdiction to hear _____ actions arising under section 3767.50 of the Revised Code and in _____ those actions to make findings and orders pertaining to blighted _____ parcels;

(B) When in aid of execution of a judgment of the _____ environmental division of the municipal court rendered _____ pursuant to section 3767.50 of the Revised Code, in actions for _____ the foreclosure of a mortgage on real property given to secure the _____ payment of money, or the enforcement of a specific lien for money _____ or other encumbrance or charge on real property, when the real _____ property is situated within the territory, to foreclose all _____ liens and all vested and contingent rights, render _____ judgments, and make findings and orders, between the parties, in _____ the same manner and to the same extent as in similar cases in the _____ court of common pleas.
