Section 2107.58 Order of sale to pay debts.

Effective: January 13, 2012

Legislation: Senate Bill 124 - 129th General Assembly

When a sale of real property alienated or unalienated by a devisee or heir is ordered for the payment of the debts of an estate, sections 2107.53 to 2107.57 of the Revised Code do not prevent the probate court from making an order and decree for the sale of any portion of the alienated or unalienated real property that is equitable among the parties, and making an order of contribution and further order and decree to settle and adjust the various rights and liabilities of the parties.
