Section 2725.10 Form of writ when prisoner not in custody of an officer.

Effective: October 1, 1953

Legislation: House Bill 1 - 100th General Assembly

In case of confinement, imprisonment, or detention by a person not an officer, the writ of habeas corpus shall be in the following form:

To the sheriff of our several counties, greeting:

We command you that the body of _____ of _____, by _____, of _____, imprisoned and restrained of his liberty, as it is said, you take and have before _____, a judge of our _____ court, or, in case of his absence or disability, before some other judge of the same court, at _____, forthwith to do and receive what our said judge shall then and there consider _____ concerning him in his behalf; and summon the said _____ then and there to appear before our said judge, to show the cause of the taking and detention of the said _____
