Section 3333.049 Reading endorsement programs; instruction in computer science and computational thinking.

Effective: September 30, 2021

Legislation: House Bill 110 - 134th General Assembly

- (A) Not later than July 1, 2016, the chancellor of higher education shall revise the requirements for reading endorsement programs offered by institutions of higher education to align those requirements with the reading competencies adopted by the state board of education under section 3301.077 of the Revised Code.
- (B) Each educator preparation program approved under section 3333.048 of the Revised Code shall require each candidate for an educator license who enters the program in the 2022-2023 academic year, or any academic year thereafter, to receive instruction in computer science and computational thinking, as applied to student learning and classroom instruction, as appropriate for the grade level and subject area of the candidate's prospective educator license.
