Section 4731.091 Qualified graduate of fifth pathway training program.

Effective: September 29, 2017

Legislation: House Bill 49 - 132nd General Assembly

To be recognized by the state medical board as a qualified graduate of a fifth pathway training program, an applicant shall submit evidence satisfactory to the board that the applicant has done all of the following:

- (A) Studied medicine in a foreign medical school acknowledged by the world health organization and verified by a member state of that organization as operating within the state's jurisdiction at the time the applicant studied medicine;
 - (B) Successfully completed all the formal requirements of the foreign medical school except internship or social service requirements;
 - (C) Prior to entrance into the fifth pathway training program, attained on a screening examination acceptable to the board a score satisfactory to a medical school accredited by the liaison committee on medical education;
 - (D) Successfully completed one academic year of fifth pathway training at a hospital affiliated with a medical school accredited by the liaison committee on medical education.
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
