Before restoring to a good standing a certificate issued under Chapter 4734. of the Revised Code which has been suspended for any cause for more than two years, the chiropractic examining board may require the applicant to pass an oral and written examination, but under no circumstances shall an applicant take only an oral exam, to determine his present fitness to resume practice.

The authority of the board to impose terms and conditions includes the following:

- (A) Requiring the applicant to obtain training and to pass an examination upon completion of such training;
- (B) Restricting or limiting the extent, scope, or type of practice of the applicant.

The board shall consider the moral character and the activities of the applicant during the period of suspension or inactivity, in accordance with this chapter.
